2. Hard hats to be worn at all times to current safety standards, when mounted chin straps to be fastened.
3. All dogs to be kept on lead at all times.
4. Ages taken from January 1st 2009
5. No mucking out of trailers/lorries
6. Any misuse of whips, failure to obey an order from a judge or steward, or discourteous behaviour may result in dismissal.
7. Ridden horses and ponies to be 4 or over.
8. Organisers reserve the right to alter the programme
9. Leading rein competitors snaffle bridles only to remain on L.R for duration of show, except for assisted jumping class. LR attached to noseband.
10. No horse or pony to be left unattended if tethered to outside of vehicle.
11. No weaned colts or stallions
