

MORE CLIFTON HOUSING DEVELOPMENT PROPOSED

Land adjoining Hope Lane in Clifton-upon-Teme has been earmarked by Malvern Hills planners for a further 50 new houses, following publication this month of draft proposals for the South Worcestershire Development Plan which identify the 'preferred options' for housing development in the county.

Clifton appears on a list of Category 1 village sites in the plan considered "the most sustainable rural locations in South Worcestershire. They will be the focus for the level of development which is genuinely required to meet the needs of the rural area throughout the development plan period".

A consultation event is scheduled to take place in Clifton later this year on **Wednesday, 19th October.**

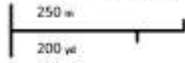
Clifton Parish Council chairman, Bernard Pound, said: "The planners have now identified just one area in Clifton within their preferred options document for the development plan for South Worcestershire.

This is land in Hope Lane opposite Winnington Close where they are suggesting 50 new houses but no actual planning applications have been made yet. The South Worcestershire Development Plan appears to be a long term thing, so I don't think we are likely to see any development soon, but parishioners might want to make their opinions known to Malvern Hill District Council. If and when any detailed proposals are forthcoming, we will of course have them on a parish council meeting agenda."
